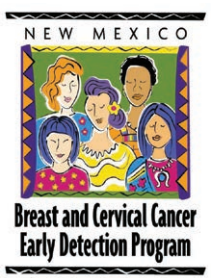

3D and 2D Full-field Digital Mammograms

Assured Imaging is a leading provider of mobile digital mammography. We are proud to be the **first to offer mobile 3D technology** in the Southwest United States! Assured Imaging strives to offer the latest in technology to our patients and we are excited to provide this service!

How are 3D screenings different? Tomosynthesis obtains multiple images from a variety of angles through the entire breast. Fine details are no longer hidden by surrounding tissue as they would be with a two-dimensional mammogram screening.

Women's Health Exams

A Health Exam includes:

- A consultation and assessment of your current health status
- A breast exam to check for any abnormalities
- A full pelvic exam
- A Pap test to screen for cervical cancer



Full-body Bone Density Scans

A DEXA scan measures bone density, which is directly related to bone strength. Doctors can predict the potential for fractures and osteoporosis through DEXA scan results.

- Screening is recommended for women >50 years of age
- Although osteoporosis is more common in women, men can also develop the condition

Wellness Assessment

It is estimated that only about 17% of U.S. adults are considered to be in a state of optimal mental health. Patients answer series of multiple choice questions (privately on a hand-held tablet), which measure likelihood for depression, anxiety, alcohol and substance abuse and other common psychological issues affecting their overall health and well being. Results are reviewed by a state licensed psychiatric and mental health provider.

Skin Cancer Screenings

One of the best ways you can protect your health is to get your skin checked to identify any cancerous or pre-cancerous moles. When cancer is found at an early stage, it is often easier to treat.

- Head-to-toe body screenings are performed by a MSN, FNP-C specializing in dermatology.
- Liquid Nitrogen Treatment (freezing of any precancerous cells)
- Clinician provides feedback and treatment recommendations



Diabetic Screenings

A1C and Diabetic Urinalysis: These tests help monitor important renal function levels in diabetic patients.

Ankle-brachial Index Test: Checks for peripheral artery disease, a risk factor for patients with diabetes.

Diabetic Retinopathy Screening:

- Anyone with Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes should receive a retinal eye exam every year as recommended by The American Academy of Ophthalmology.
- Early detection can reduce the risk of severe vision loss by 90%. Unfortunately, fewer than 50% of patients with diabetes get a diabetic eye screening annually.
- An Assured Imaging retinal exam is painless and takes less than five minutes to complete. No dilation required for most patients!

Fecal Immunochemical Test for occult blood

Heart Health Screenings

We can help you stay stroke free!

PVI: Stroke/Carotid Artery Screening

Ultrasound evaluation of the carotid arteries that screens for buildup of fatty plaque - the leading cause of strokes.

ABI: Peripheral Arterial Disease Screening

Evaluates for plaque buildup in the lower extremities. It is 4-5 times more likely you will die from heart disease if you have peripheral arterial disease.

AAA: Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Screening

Ultrasound is used to check for aneurysms in the abdomen that may be at risk of rupturing.
